- Facilitate enactment of the maritime sector related legislation.
- Facilitate the formation of AP Maritime Board - deliberating and coordinating with various maritime stakeholders, drafting documents like Memorandum of Association etc. and all other incidental tasks necessary for establishing a board.
- Assist in the implementation of AP Port Policy 2015.
- Assist in developing and drafting the AP Maritime Board Charter.
- Drafting maritime related documents like concession agreements, supplementary agreements, state support agreements, development agreements, PPP Contracts, Land Lease Agreements etc. based on model agreements or otherwise.
- Drafting Articles of Association, Memorandum of Association and other such deeds for maritime linked industries/bodies etc.
- Assist in the effective implementation of port and coastal security for the non-major ports in the state for safety of ports and maritime stakeholder within the state and in territorial

waters; which effectuates international conventions and national legislations in force in the sector.

- Facilitate development of a Maritime Law Programme in the Maritime University in AP.
- Assist in preparing the Coastal Master Plan to identify potential projects for development along the coast.
- Research, analyze and present a comparative study of various maritime policies in and around the country and other maritime nations to develop new and innovative maritime policies and programs for AP. Study the best practices of all the ports of neighbouring states to develop AP as a model state in the port sector.
