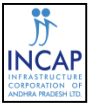

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Request for Qualification

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1. INTRODUCTION

1.1. **Background**

- 1.1.1. Government of Andhra Pradesh is engaged in the development of various infrastructure projects across sectors including but not limited to:
- Ports
 - Roads and Bridges including beach tourism corridor
 - Urban infrastructure like convention centres, sports complexes, international schools, golf courses, bus/truck terminals etc.
- 1.1.2. Infrastructure Corporation of Andhra Pradesh (INCAP) (the “**Authority**”) is providing advisory services to the Government of Andhra Pradesh for implementation of the aforesaid projects.
- 1.1.3. With the view to empanel consultants for preparing Terms of References for Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) study, conducting environmental studies for the upcoming projects and assisting the Authority in conducting public hearings and obtaining environmental clearances and approvals from various state and central agencies, the Authority invites Proposals for forming a panel of Consultancy Firms.

1.2. **Release of RFQ Document**

- 1.2.1. The RFQ document will be made available in the website of INCAP from the date of publication of RFQ notification in the News Papers.
- 1.2.2. The Applicant needs to furnish, as part of its Proposal, a fee of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) in the form of a Demand Draft issued by one of the Nationalised/ Scheduled Banks in India in favour of the Vice Chairman and Managing Director, INCAP Ltd., payable at Hyderabad towards non-refundable Proposal processing fee (the “**Proposal Processing Fee**”). The Proposal Processing Fee shall have its validity up to 30 (thirty) days from the Proposal Due Date (the “**Proposal Due Date**”).

1.3. **Validity of the Proposal**

- 1.3.1. The RFQ Proposal shall indicate that it shall remain valid for a period of minimum 3 (three) years from the last date of submission of the RFQ with a provision for extension without change in terms and conditions.
- 1.3.2. The empanelment of the consultant shall get automatically terminated even before validity period of 3 (three) years if its Quality Counsel of India (QCI) accreditation is withdrawn.
- 1.3.3. Empanelment is also liable for cancellation if at any stage it is found that the documents/information submitted in the Proposal is false.
- 1.3.4. The Authority shall have the right to terminate the empanelment by giving a written notice to the Consultant without any compensation if the empanelled Consultant becomes bankrupt or otherwise insolvent or in case of dissolution of the firm or winding up of the

company, provided that such termination will not prejudice or effect any right of action or remedy, which has accrued thereafter to the Authority.

1.4. Brief description of the Selection Process

- 1.4.1. The Authority intends to select the Consultant(s) through an open competitive bidding process in accordance with the procedure set out herein.
- 1.4.2. This RFQ document will be used to select a panel of upto 8 (eight) consultants, using the score obtained in Evaluation Criteria (detailed in Clause 3.1) in descending order, who will be empaneled to conduct environmental studies as per the scope defined in Clause 2.1.
- 1.4.3. If the number of qualified respondents is less than 6 (six), the Authority reserves the right to reduce the minimum eligibility criteria and/or evaluation criteria for technical proposal.
- 1.4.4. A Request for Proposal (RFP) for each infrastructure project as described in Clause 1.1.1 will be released to all the empaneled consultants.
 - a) For each engagement / assignment the Authority would specifically define the scope of engagement, which may include components beyond the defined scope in this RFQ and call for a Limited RFP to the Empanelled agencies.
 - b) As per the selection criteria detailed in the respective RFPs, the Consultant shall be selected.
- 1.4.5. The selected consultant after the RFP shall carry out EIA study as per guidelines issued from time to time by Ministry of Environment & Forests (MOEF), Government of India. The consultant shall also assist in getting the necessary environmental clearance from MOEF or any Government authority.

2. INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANTS

2.1. Scope of Proposal

2.1.1. **Role of Consultant:** The empanelled consultant will provide consultancy services for various infrastructure projects in the course of the empanelment period. A consultant would be selected from the empanelled list for each such project. The consultant would be responsible for assisting the executing agency in conducting environmental and social studies and securing approvals from the Central Government or the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority.

The selected consultant would have to wholly or partly undertake the process described below

1) **Categorization of projects**

Based on the nature of the project, its extent and its impact the consultant will assist in categorization of the projects as per Ministry of Environment and Forests Guidelines. Depending on the categorization the consultant would prepare an outline of the study and approval process.

2) **Making proposals to the Screening, Scoping and Appraisal Committees**

The selected consultant would make the project proposal for the Central or State level screening scoping and appraisal committee as the need may be in the applicable formats

3) **Application for prior environmental clearance and Scoping**

Based on the available techno-economic feasibility studies, the consultant would apply for prior environmental clearance with the necessary formats and assist in getting the terms of reference (ToR) approved for the Environment Clearance wherever applicable.

4) **Undertaking the Environment Studies as per the approved ToR**

For projects requiring impact studies, the consultant would undertake the Environmental Impact Assessment Study as per the approved ToR. All technical studies available with the executing agency would be made available to the consultant. All other necessary sampling and tests will need to be carried out by the consultant.

5) **Public Consultations**

The consultant would assist the executing agency in co-ordinating with the concerned pollution control board, undertake the necessary public consultations, advise the

executing agency on remedial measures and compile the EIA report addressing the highlighted concerns.

6) Securing Environmental Clearance

The consultant will submit the EIA report to the approving authority and assist the executing agency in securing the environmental clearance for the project.

2.1.2. Key Personnel

The Applicant shall propose mandatory key personnel for the following positions:

Sl. No.	Position	Minimum Qualification	Minimum Experience
1.	EIA Coordinator / Team Leader	Post Graduate degree in Environmental Engineering/ Environmental Science with experience in Environmental Impact Analysis	10 years
2.	Environmental Engineer / Planner	Post Graduate degree in Environmental Engineering / Environmental Science with experience in Environmental Impact Analysis	5 years
3.	Social Scientist	Post Graduate degree in social work/sociology/Environmental Economics with experience in public consultation/social analysis	5 years
4.	Hydrologist/ Geologist	Post Graduate degree in the relevant field with experience in Ground Water and Watershed Management. Knowledge on interpretation of satellite data and GIS mapping preferred.	5 years

Note: 1) No Key Personnel should have attained the age of 75 (seventy five) years at the time of submitting the Proposal

2) The aforementioned key personnel shall not be substituted during the empanelment period. However, substitution shall be permitted if the Key Personnel is not available for reasons of any incapacity or due to health, subject to equally or better qualified and experienced personnel being provided to the satisfaction of the Authority.

2.2. Minimum Eligibility Criteria for Empanelment

2.2.1. The Applicant shall be a company / a corporate body incorporated under the Companies Act, 1956 or the Companies Act, 2013 or a limited liability partnership (LLP)

incorporated under the Limited Liability Partnership Act, 2008. Certificate of Incorporation/ Registration shall be furnished for the same.

- 2.2.2. The Applicant shall be a single entity applying for empanelment process.
- 2.2.3. The Applicant should not have a conflict of interest that affects the empanelment process. Any Applicant found to have a Conflict of Interest shall be disqualified.
- 2.2.4. Any entity which has been barred by the Central/ State Government, or any entity controlled by it, from participating in any project, and the bar subsists as on the date of RFQ, would not be eligible to submit a RFQ.
- 2.2.5. An Applicant, in the last 3 years, have neither failed to perform on any contract, as evidenced by imposition of a penalty by an arbitral or judicial authority or a judicial pronouncement or arbitration award against the Applicant, as the case may be, nor has been expelled from any project or contract by any public entity nor have had any contract terminated by any public entity for breach by such Applicant.
- 2.2.6. The Applicant must have been accredited by QCI under NABET for Empanelment of Environmental Impact Assessment Consultant, recognized by Ministry of Environment & Forest in atleast 2 (two) of the following 3 (three) sectors:
 - a) Highways, Railways, transport terminals, mass rapid transport system
 - b) Ports, harbours, jetties, marine terminals, break waters and dredging
 - c) Building and large construction projects including shopping malls, multiplexes, commercial complexes, housing estates, hospitals, institutionsThey must produce the registration certificate/ number and latest surveillance audit report to confirm that they have a valid registration/ recognition.
- 2.2.7. The Applicant must have their own laboratory recognized by MOEF or any other competent authority to ensure qualitative analysis of relevant parameters in effective and time bound manner. Applicants without their own lab shall not be considered.
- 2.2.8. Documentary proof of meeting above eligibility criteria must be furnished as per Appendix I – Form 6 and Form 7.
- 2.2.9. The Applicant must have a team of experts for conducting EIA study/clearance.
- 2.2.10. **Financial Capacity:** The Applicant should have an annual Gross Turnover of not less than Rs. 5 crore (Rs. Five crore) from professional fees in each of the last three financial years. The Firm will be required to submit an authenticated copy of the audited annual accounts of each of the three years giving details of Turnover and other financial parameters along with the Proposal. Proposals without audited annual accounts are liable to be rejected.
- 2.2.11. **Technical Capacity:** The Applicant must have completed at least 3 (three) Eligible Assignments as defined in Clause 3.2. Out of these assignments atleast 1 (one) should be

for coastal development projects i.e. ports, building, hotel, etc. in Coastal Regulation Zone area.

2.2.12. The consultancy firm must have a minimum of 3 (three) years of experience in conducting environmental studies for projects such as ports, roads, social infrastructure like convention centres, sports stadia, international schools, golf courses etc. sector projects.

2.2.13. The Applicant firms may note that mere meeting of the minimum eligibility criteria does not entitle them for empanelment. The applicants meeting the minimum eligibility criteria will be further short-listed for Evaluation. Technical Proposal of only those firms will be evaluated who meets the minimum eligibility criteria.

2.3. Cost of Proposal

2.3.1. The Applicants shall be responsible for all of the costs associated with the preparation of their Proposals and their participation in the Selection Process including subsequent negotiation, visits to the Authority, Project site etc. The Authority will not be responsible or in any way liable for such costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the Selection Process.

2.4. Acknowledgement by Applicant

2.4.1. It shall be deemed that by submitting the Proposal, the Applicant has:

- a) made a complete and careful examination of the RFQ;
- b) received all relevant information requested from the Authority;
- c) acknowledged and accepted the risk of inadequacy, error or mistake in the information provided in the RFQ or furnished by or on behalf of the Authority;
- d) acknowledged that it does not have a Conflict of Interest.

2.4.2. The Authority shall not be liable for any omission, mistake or error on the part of the Applicant in respect of any of the above or on account of any matter or thing arising out of or concerning or relating to RFQ or the Selection Process, including any error or mistake therein or in any information or data given by the Authority.

2.5. Right to reject any or all Proposals

2.5.1. Notwithstanding anything contained in this RFQ, the Authority reserves the right to accept or reject any Proposal and to annul the Selection Process and reject all Proposals, at any time without any liability or any obligation for such acceptance, rejection or annulment, and without assigning any reasons thereof.

2.5.2. The proposal received without Proposal Processing Fee or other requisite documents shall be rejected.

2.5.3. Without prejudice to the generality of Clause 2.5.1, the Authority reserves the right to reject any Proposal if:

- a) at any time, a material misrepresentation is made or discovered, or
 - b) the Applicant does not provide, within the time specified by the Authority, the supplemental information sought by the Authority for evaluation of the Proposal.
- 2.5.4. Misrepresentation/ improper response by the Applicant may lead to the disqualification of the Applicant.
- 2.5.5. Receipt of Proposal beyond the Proposal Due Date shall result in disqualification.
- 2.5.6. Additionally the Proposals may lead to disqualification under, inter-alia, any of the following circumstances:
- a) Prior suspension by Government of Andhra Pradesh, whether in a capacity as a consulting firm or individual consultant.
 - b) A record of unsatisfactory past performance, particularly non-compliance with contract terms, plans and specifications or abandonment of work and similar deficiencies.

2.6. Amendment of RFQ

- 2.6.1. At any time prior to the deadline for submission of Proposal, the Authority may, for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to clarifications requested by an Applicant, modify the RFQ document by the issuance of Addendum/ Amendment.
- 2.6.2. The amendments will be posted on the Official Website along with the revised RFQ containing the amendments and will be binding on all Applicants.
- 2.6.3. In order to afford the Applicants a reasonable time for taking an amendment into account, or for any other reason, the Authority may, in its sole discretion, extend the Proposal Due Date.

2.7. Preparation and Submission of Proposal

2.7.1. Language

The Proposal with all accompanying documents (the “**Documents**”) and all communications in relation to or concerning the Selection Process shall be in English language and strictly on the forms provided in this RFQ. No supporting document or printed literature shall be submitted with the Proposal unless specifically asked for and in case any of these Documents is in another language, it must be accompanied by an accurate translation of the relevant passages in English, in which case, for all purposes of interpretation of the Proposal, the translation in English shall prevail.

2.7.2. Submission of Proposal

- 2.7.2.1. The Applicants shall submit the Proposal in hard bound form with all pages numbered serially and by giving an index of submissions. Each page of the submission shall be initialled by the Authorized Representative of the Applicant as per the terms of the RFQ.

Soft copies of the Proposal in MS Word and PDF formats shall also be submitted in a Compact Disk.

2.7.2.2. The Proposal from the Consultants must contain the following:
